Art and Design Journals Retrospective

This new service from Design Research Publications aims to digitize important decorative and fine arts journals published in Europe and the United States during the 19th and early 20th centuries. The first two journals to be digitized in this effort are *The Studio* (London, volumes 1-50, 1893-1910) and *Deutsche Kunst und Dekoration* (Darmstadt, Germany: volumes 1-27, 1897-1910).

This effort will make these and other journals available online for the first time in an indexed, searchable form. Having these journals available to the Washington University community could contribute to scholarship in visual culture, European studies, art history, literary studies and other subject areas, possibly opening up new areas of research.
