Middle Eastern and Central Asian Studies is a bibliographic index of research, policy, and scholarly publications on the countries and peoples of the Middle East, Central Asia and North Africa. Subjects covered within the index include politics and law, international relations, business and industry, the arts and culture, social welfare, ethnic diversity and anthropology, religious events and movements, recent history, and archaeology. The database reflects materials from 1900 to the present. It is updated annually and currently includes more than 330,000 records.

MECAS provides access to some of the most up-to-date research on an extremely important area of the world—the Middle East, Central Asia and North Africa—and thus is valuable to a variety of scholars.
