

## **Hudson E. Bridge Collection, 1863-1871**

Biographical note/Scope and content:

Hudson E. Bridge, a St. Louis railroad executive, was one of the original members of Washington University's Board of Trustees. The nine letters in this collection deal with various aspects of University business, particularly with gifts that Bridge made to the University.
