## **Biographical Note**

Alexander Suss Langsdorf, son of Adolph and Sarah (Suss) Langsdorf was born August 31, 1877 in St. Louis, Missouri. Graduating from St. Louis High School in 1894, he received a Bachelor of Science degree from the School of Engineering at Washington University in 1898, and a M.M.E. [Masters of Mechanical Engineering] from Cornell University in 1901.

Alexander Langsdorf married Elsie Hirsh June 26, 1906 and had two children. Their daughter Helen (Shiman) (BS '29) married and had three children, Paul, Elsa, and Steven. Their son Alexander Langsdorf, Jr. (BS '32) married Martyl Schweig (BS '38) in 1941 and had two children, Suzanne and Alexandra (Sandie).

Alexander Suss Langsdorf served as a Professor of Electrical Engineering at Washington University from 1901 – 1910. He continued as a Professor of Engineering and served as Dean of the Washington University School of Engineering and Architecture from 1910 – 1920 and from 1929 – 1948. Between 1950 and 1973 Langsdorf served as a Professor Emeritus of Engineering. Professor Alexander Suss Langsdorf died in St. Louis, November 9, 1973.
