Historical Note

The Washington University Libraries Organizing Committee (WULOC) was created by Olin Library staff in 1986 –1987 during a period of library administrative re-organization and re-structuring. The group expanded its focus in 1988 with the goal of organizing all non-faculty staff members on the Danforth (Hilltop) Campus. In 1988 the group's name was changed to the Washington University Labor Organizing Committee (WULOC).
